Halliwell is a purpose-built Care Home providing nursing care set in beautiful grounds on the outskirts of historic Royal Tunbridge Wells.

Although Halliwell is a large and modern nursing home, it is both warm and welcoming throughout.

The Home has 64 rooms arranged over two floors, accessible by lifts. All rooms have their own front door and en-suite facilities, many with showers, and most have views over the landscaped gardens. We have five well-appointed sitting areas where residents can enjoy a relaxing and convivial atmosphere.

We have a state-of-the-art call system that allows residents to alert staff from their rooms and the surrounding gardens.

We are proud of our high standard of cuisine and can cater for a wide range of dietary requirements.

Visitors are always welcome at Halliwell and if residents wish to invite friends or relatives to join them for a meal, we simply ask for prior notice. A small charge is made for guests' meals. Refreshments are available throughout the day for both residents and guests.

An individual care plan is agreed with a named nurse and regularly reviewed with the resident and their family if appropriate. Residents are encouraged to live as independently as they wish and staff are on duty 24 hours a day to help in every possible way.



Medical care is undertaken by a local GP. Visits by the GP can be arranged or assistance offered to attend the local surgery.

In addition to long-term care, we offer convalescent, palliative and respite care. If someone is living at home but being cared for by relatives or friends, we can arrange for them to come in for a short stay to give their carers a holiday.

## *facilities and activities*



We believe residents should retain as much of their independence and mobility as possible. Important to staying fit and active is the stimulus of living with like-minded people. In addition, residents can enjoy trips in our specially adapted minibus to places of interest and entertainment or simply to the local shops.

There is a continuous programme of events, including a gentle fitness exercise programme led by our highly-experienced, events co-ordinator.

‘Friends of Halliwell House’, made up of local volunteers, take a great interest in Halliwell by visiting and befriending residents. Residents, of course, are free to participate in the leisure activities that appeal to them most.

### How to get to Halliwell

Take the M25 and leave at exit 5, taking the A21 towards Hastings. Ignore the first sign to Tunbridge Wells, which is at Tonbridge. Keep on the A21, until

Pembury then follow the signs to Tunbridge Wells, down Pembury Road. Kingswood Road is the second turning on the left at the end of Pembury Road where the road divides.

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
